Car Parking:

The council have informed us that they will be carrying out parking inspections more regularly this term so please be considerate to our neighbours, ensure that driveways are kept clear and **never** park on double yellow lines/zig zags during drop off and collection times. There is a voluntary one way system in place from **8.30am to 9.00am** and from **2.30pm to 3.30pm** to ease the traffic in Brook Lane at these times.

May we also remind you not to use the school car park at **any** time. Many of our pupils cannot be seen clearly when they are behind a vehicle and we have had near misses on numerous occasions.

We must enforce this for your child's safety.
