The Safer Schools App is designed for parents/carers, school staff and pupils. It helps support and protect children by educating and empowering them both at school and at home. Adult users receive tailored content specific to their role and pupils receive different content depending on their year group.

The app provides information and guidance on a range of topics to help keep children in your care safer online.

Advice covers topics such as bullying, gaming, inappropriate images, social media and much more.

You will also receive school-generated notifications and updates from the h2b Safer team on keeping children and young people safe. Please do make sure you have push notifications enabled to stay up-to-date.

Download the app for free by searching for '**Safer Schools**' in the Apple App Store or on Google play. (You can download it on more than one device!)

Step 3:

Enter the entry code **7512** in the box.
